The topics that we will be covering during this term of
'Pole to Pole' are;

Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Performance poems● Fables● Instructions & explanations● Information texts● Poetry – image poems● Fairy stories and playscripts● Argument & debate
Numeracy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Number and Place Value, including; understanding of digits, rounding, ordering, counting on and counting back.● Four rules of number; Mental and written strategies for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.● Fractions, including decimals.● Measures● Properties of shape● Statistics
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Animals including Humans – looking into balanced diets, digestive systems, human and animal skeletons, the effects of exercise on the human body and a brief look at our teeth● Electricity – constructing electrical circuits, using lamps, bulbs, buzzers, switches. Investigating insulators and conductors.
Computing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Using technology safely, respectfully and responsibly.● Understanding computer networks – using search technologies.● Considering how to select, use and combine a variety of software, also evaluating and presenting data and information.● Design, write and debug programs, whilst using sequence, selection, and repetition.
Geography	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● POLE TO POLE In this topic, we will be delving into the Arctic and Antarctica, locating these on maps and finding out all about the wildlife and how polar expeditions succeed, hopefully involving a visitor who has visited both places.
DT / Art	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Art – Polar wildlife sketching and painting.● DT – Electric light up Christmas card. <p>For both, we will research ideas using shop bought items and the internet, plan and design, make / create and then evaluate our work and that of others.</p>
PE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Net and wall games – extending skills when playing games with rackets / balls, considering skills required particularly in netball and hockey.● Invasion games – working and playing as a team, using attacking and defensive strategies.● Participation in the 'Young Leaders' programme (Y5 only)
RE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Judaism: Why is Moses important to Jewish people today and what do they learn about him from God? Why is Pesach important to Jews?

Music	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Perform, listen to, review and evaluate music across a range of styles, looking at music of the Intuits' and Night on Bare Mountain, to help us to create a piece of music of the Artic Ocean.
PSHCE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● School, class and other rules, children's rights and responsibilities and how this works in the local community / environment.
