The foci for our learning within the topic of "Pole to Pole" are

English	 Mystery stories -we will be studying Marcus Sedgwick's Floodlands as inspiration for our own mystery stories. Recounts. Instructions & Explanations. Tales from other cultures Narrative poems.
Maths	 Applying knowledge of number and place value to order numbers and round. Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of whole numbers and decimals. Fractions, decimals, percentages and the relationship between the two. Measures – units and how to convert between them and area and perimeter Time – timetables and problem solving. Geometry - 2d and 3d shapes, angles. Strategies for problem solving.
Science	 Our solar system. The Earth, sun and Moon – what causes day and night, the seasons and the phases of the moon. Electricity – building circuits, how electricity moves round a circuit, what affects bulb brightness and drawing circuits using recognised symbols.
Computing	 Using search technologies to retrieve information. Combining information and presenting it in a variety of ways and tailoring to particular audiences. Storing and analysing data using Excel. Revision of coding terms. Programming and coding.

Geography	 Using atlases to locate: continents, countries, major cities, rivers and mountain ranges
	 ranges. Locating the lines of latitude/longitude, the equator and the tropics of
	Cancer/Capricorn.
	Investigating the Arctic and Antarctic environments.
DT / Art	Art - Sketching – refining sketching skills to draw a polar animal.
	D.T – Electric light up Christmas cards.
PE	 Net and wall games – extending skills when playing games with rackets / balls, considering skills required particularly in netball and hockey.
	Invasion games – working and playing as a team, using attacking and defensive strategies.
	Participation in the 'Young Leaders' programme (Y5 only)
RE	Judaism – who Moses is and why is he significant.
	How Jewish people practise their faith – The Synagogue, Shabbat and Pesach.
Music	Singing –working towards understanding the beat and rhythm of songs.
	Composing our own Autumn themed songs.

PSHCE	British Values – the rule of law – what does law mean? Where do laws come from?
