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# Dear Parents

I am delighted to be taking on the role of Headteacher of Eastington Primary. Having been privileged to learn the craft of teaching here at the start of my career with Miss Greening and Mr Strang it feels wonderful to return and offer something back to the community. I am committed to supporting your child in reaching their full potential: socially, emotionally and academically. Eastington has a strong and committed staff team and I know we can continue to work with you to ensure the best outcomes for your child.

It has been a great start to the term. The new Reception pupils are settling well under the guidance of Mrs Parsons and Mrs Williams. Thank you for making the transition to school smooth by arriving on time and offering positive words when needed. It has been impressive to see how the children in Class 1 have started to use the word already to describe their learning. Particular congratulations to Harun who was spotted showing resilience while playing with cars and tubes. He didn't give up when one of the cars got stuck and solved the problem for himself. Great learning skills! It has been a real pleasure hearing that so many children have been talking to you about the times when you have been resilient too.
