

Their visit to Eastington was an super opportunity to further strengthen our links with Kenya and help our understanding of different systems and cultures. Mr Dougan also shared his experience from his latest visit to Kenya including a special present to the children of Eastington.....the adoption of an orphaned elephant called Roi. Roi was just 10months old when found next to his dead mother in the wild. He is now safely being cared for at the Olare Orok Wildlife Conservancy, Maasi Mara until his return to the wild. Wonderful indeed!
